From **Worcester**, take Stafford St. west about **12** miles thru **Rochdale**. The cemetery is about **1/2** mile on the right, off the hi-way, after crossing the "**Charlton Town Line**".

From **Charlton** at the intersection of **Rt. 20** and Main St., go north about **1** mile to Stafford St. Turn right [east] on Stafford St. and go about **3** miles. The cemetery is on the left hand side [north] of the road. and before reaching the "Charlton – Rochedale Town Line"
