 From Worcester, take Rt. **20** west about **16** miles to Charlton. Left at traffic light on North Main St. Go beyond the Town Hall and turn left at Bay Path Cemetery. Go less than a mile and bear right on to Freeman Rd. Go about 2 ½ - 3 miles to the 4 way stop. The Advent Church can be seen at the intersection on the right. Go straight ahead just a short distance and turn right on to Haggerty Rd. The Fitts Burial Yard is about 1 ½ miles south of the Advent Church. It sets about **413** ft [30 rods] off of the road and is about **30** ft x **50** ft in size and surrounded on **4** sides by field stone walls.
