CHARLTON OLD HOME DAY FROG JUMPING CONTEST

CONTEST RULES & REGULATIONS

- Contest open to children who are between 3 to 14 years of age.
- Each contestant must supply his/her own frog.
- Contestants are responsible to ensure that their entry is a frog. **NO TOADS ALLOWED!!!**
- While waiting to compete, all contestants must keep their frog(s) moist in a well ventilated container that will maintain an average temperature of 60 degrees Fahrenheit to ensure the well-being of the frog(s).
- Each contestant may only enter the contest once.
- Each frog will only be allowed to jump in one event.
- Contestants may not be accompanied or assisted in the frog jumping area.
- To begin the event, each contestant must place his/her frog on the jumping pad.
- After a frog is placed on the jumping pad the frog may not be touched to make it jump.
- Each contestant may jump up and down, shout, blow or coax his or her frog to get it to jump.
- Each frog will be scored by marking the distances of three consecutive jumps.
- Judges with marking pins will mark the three jumps by placing a pin at each location where the frog lands.
- Prizes for First, Second and Third place will be given out to the winners in the following categories: #1. The longest first jump. #2. The longest single jump. #3. The longest distance of the three combined jumps.
- Contestants will be responsible to ensure that each frog is safely returned at the conclusion of the frog jumping contest to the respective location where it was caught.
