

Nomination Form for Community Service Awards

Each year the Charlton Old Home Day Committee seeks nominations for Community Service Awards for Charlton businesses or residents. The awards are intended to recognize the volunteer work in the community, schools and service to fellow citizens. In the past, typical awards have been given for volunteering in the senior center to serve meals to senior citizens, collecting and distributing food with CHIP-In, collecting and distributing clothing or toys to the needy, doing a project which benefits residents such as a walkway or bridge along hiking trails. The awards are not intended for those, who in the course of their traditional occupation complete their tasks, but for those who perform the good deeds purely out of volunteerism and civic duty.

Whatever the endeavor, big or small, these people deserve to be recognized and applauded for their efforts. If you know of an individual and during the course of the current year (August to August), then please complete this nomination form for the consideration of an award.

Categories

- **Citizen of the Year** – This award would be of the highest honor with consistent presence and repeated acts of major impact.
- **Honorary Parade Marshall** – This award goes to long time residents who during the course of their lifetime here in Charlton have consistently improved our quality of life.
- **Individual Community Service Award** – This award is given to those, who on a smaller scale, have made some contribution which has brightened our little corner of the world, either by coaching sports for a long period of time, acting as a long time scout leader, volunteering at the animal shelter, raising funds for animal welfare, the needy and such. More than one of these awards may be presented.
- **Business Award** – This award is intended to recognize local businesses, who, on a regular basis, support community events, groups or activities.
- **Youth Community Service Award** – Established in 2011, this award is intended to recognize the positive contributions of a young member of the community younger than the age of 18 who has altruistically pursued humane efforts in improving the world in which we live. Such an award is to establish an example for others of a young age to follow.
