Present: Chairman – Frederick C. Swensen, Vice-Chairman – Joseph J. Szafarowicz, Clerk – Cynthia B. Cooper and Members – David M. Singer and John P. McGrath. Also present: Town Administrator - Robin L. Craver.

*NOTE: Some matters may have been taken out of agenda order but were typed up in agenda order for ease of locating information when necessary.*

I. Call to Order:

1. Chairman Swensen called the meeting to order with the pledge to the flag.
2. Chairman Swensen reminded everyone to treat each other courteously and be acknowledged by the Chair before speaking. Those in attendance are requested to turn off cell phones or put them on vibrate so as not to disrupt the proceedings and remove hats, if any.

II. Consent Agenda:

1. Minutes of Selectmen's Regular Meeting – October 28, 2014. **Motion by Mr. Singer to accept the minutes, seconded by Mr. McGrath, motion carries unanimously.**

I. Community Relations, Announcements and Open Forum:

- Chairman Swensen read the announcements.
- Cheryl Hansen, Library Director came forward and announced a couple of programs coming up at the Library. All programs are on the Library website.
- Darlene Emco Rollins and Kelli Devlin came forward to thank everyone for their donations of Halloween costumes for Chip-In. They collected over 70 costumes. Ms. Devlin announced that on Saturday, December 20, 2014 at Chip-In, the children of the chip-in families will be able to meet Mr. & Mrs. Claus and have their picture taken with them. The children will also receive a gift. The Board thanked them for all their work.
- Chief Pervier came forward and said that the Charlton Police Department along with the District Attorneys office as well as other departments will be joining Goods for Guns, kids and guns do not mix on Saturday, December 13, 2014 from 9am – 4pm. With gun ownership comes the responsibility of storing guns locked, unloaded and inaccessible to kids. If this is something a gun owner cannot do, the Police Department will help them by taking those guns and disposing them. They will also have free gun locks available. This program is anonymity ensured and no gun registration required. Chief Pervier also announced a few other programs the Police Department will be working on.
- Mrs. Craver wanted to remind the residents of the winter parking ban and read the policy.

IV. Appointments/Resignations:

1. Appointment – per diem dispatchers. Mrs. Craver stated that attached you will find a request from Chief Pervier to add two additional per diem dispatchers due to his current staff's inability to cover certain shifts on various days. Therefore in an effort to avoid unnecessary payment of overtime, an immediate need exists to add the requested positions. In reviewing the Charlton

Police Department's current pool of per diem dispatcher applicants, Chief Pervier interviewed and selected Joseph D. Clem and Sheri I. Kaiser whom are both certified by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts as Emergency E-911 Dispatchers. A complete background check and reference check was conducted on both and revealed that they have a clean record and a solid background and should be considered for the per diem dispatcher positions.

**Motion by Mr. Singer that we appoint Joseph D. Clem and Sheri I. Kaiser as per diem dispatchers for the Charlton Police Department, seconded by Mr. McGrath, motion carries unanimously.**

V. Scheduled Appointments:

**6:40pm** – Request to add flyer to tax bills. Mrs. Craver stated that the Recycling Committee has asked to come before the Board seeking permission to have the attached flyer put in with the next tax mailing. Town Collector Lucia Blanchette has approved of this request. Roland Jackson, Chairman of the Recycling Committee came forward and re-iterated the request. The cost would be about .07 cents per copy which is about \$440.00. He doesn't know if the Board of Health has any money to pay for this. Mrs. Craver stated that she hasn't been able to speak with Mr. Jackson yet but she spoke with John Farese from Casella who agreed to pay for the cost. **Motion by Mr. Szafarowicz to allow the Recycling Committee to attach the flyer with the next tax mailing, seconded by Mr. Singer, motion carries unanimously.** The Board thanked the Recycling Committee for their work on this.

**6:45pm** – Pole request – New Spencer Road. Mrs. Craver stated that attached you will find a request from National Grid requesting permission to locate poles, wires and fixtures including the necessary sustaining and protecting fixtures along and across the following public way: New Spencer Road. Also attached is the notice that was sent to the abutters. This request has been forwarded and approved by both the Chief of Police and Highway Superintendent. Chairman Swensen declared the hearing open at 7:10pm by reading the notice as sent to the abutters. (attached) Mr. Morales from National Grid came forward to answer any questions. No questions or comments. **Motion by Mr. McGrath to close the public hearing at 7:12pm, seconded by Mr. Szafarowicz, motion carries unanimously. Motion by Mr. McGrath to allow National Grid to put the pole and all the pertinent things they need to hold the pole up at 92 New Spencer Road, seconded by Mr. Singer, motion carries unanimously.**

**7:00pm** – Aviya Singer – UMASS Medical Child Life Services Toy Donation Drive. Mrs. Craver stated that Ms. Singer has asked to be placed on the Board's agenda. She has been scheduled for 7:00pm. Ms. Singer came forward to announce that she is collecting toy donations again this year for UMASS Medical Child Life Services Toy Donations. The last day she can accept the donated toys is December 16, 2014. The Board thanked her for her work on a great cause.

**7:15pm** – Library Trustees. Mrs. Craver stated that the Library Trustees have asked to be placed on the agenda to review the Dexter Hall Expenses that the Cable Committee brought up at the Board's last meeting. If you remember, the Cable Committee stated that they are working on securing a new location to serve as a filming studio. The Committee along with the Selectmen and Library Trustees, agreed several years ago to fund half of the Library custodian's salary in order for them to build a studio and access the library in the evening. Since the Board appointed Dick Vaughan as General Cable Manager, there is an increase in show production. The Cable Committee also stated that they were currently paid up to the end of the year with the Library. Cheryl Meskus, Chairman of the Library Trustees and Stefan Sage, Vice-Chairman of the Library Trustees came forward. Ms. Meskus stated that from the October 28<sup>th</sup> meeting and the discussion, the Library staff and Trustees have been asked questions from many citizens and wanted to clarify the funding sources and projects completed in Dexter Hall since the Library's reopening in July 2007. The fit out of the Dexter Memorial Hall in September of 2008 (including acoustical tiles/absorptive wall panels, window treatments, stage curtains, sound/audio visual system, and some basic stage lighting, cost a total of \$46,522.00 and was paid for by the Charlton Public Library Charitable Trust fund. A majority of the funding was provided

by a donation from American Optical. The Charlton Cable Committee provided names of technicians to install the sound/audio visual system in the room which cost \$8,730.00 and was paid for by the Charlton Public Library Charitable Trust Fund. The Charlton Cable Committee designed, paid for and installed the editing studio room in the rear of Dexter Hall. In addition, the Charlton Cable Committee paid for the copyright movie license that allows the Charlton Public Library to show films in the public in 2009 and 2010. The Library has paid for the movie license expense for the past 4 years out of the Charlton Public Library annual budget. The Cable Committee does pay the Town of Charlton a \$12,000 annual fee for access and use of Dexter Hall. The fee is used to supplement the Library Custodian budget. Mrs. Meskus stated that this letter will just clarify some of the issues brought up at the Board's last meeting. Chairman Swensen stated that a concern was made about what the Library would do without the \$12,000. He asked if they had a plan yet and Mrs. Meskus stated that they do not at this point.

#### VI. New Business:

1. Request to initiate hiring process for new officer – Police Department. Mrs. Craver stated that attached is a memo from Chief Pervier requesting official authorization from the Board to initiate the process for the hiring of a new officer for the Charlton Police Department due to the disability retirement of one of his full time officers. The Charlton Police Department's current authorized staffing level provides for eighteen full-time officers and due to the aforementioned retirement, his staffing level will drop to seventeen full-time officers leaving them understaffed and will result in the payment of unwarranted overtime. Chief Pervier is respectfully asking the Board of Selectmen to vote to authorize the backfilling of the open full-time patrolman's position and Mrs. Craver would recommend the same. Chief Pervier stated that he would be looking for a lateral transfer. **Motion by Mr. Singer that we approve the Chief's request to initiate the process for hiring a new police officer to fill the open full time patrolman's position, seconded by Mr. McGrath.** Mrs. Craver asked Chief Pervier how many female officers we have and he stated that we have one full time female officer. Mrs. Craver would like to see the Chief attempt to hire a female. Chief Pervier stated that he will go by the civil service lists. If we don't get any female candidates, he could request a separate list. Mr. Singer doesn't want this to be about sex or race. He feels whoever is the most qualified is who should be hired. After discussion, **vote on motion: motion carries unanimously.**
2. Beagle Club – Change in Manager. Mrs. Craver stated that attached is a request from the Charlton Beagle Club to change their manager from Michael J. Brown to Tammy A. Barnes. They have completed the required paperwork needed to complete this process. Mrs. Craver would recommend the Board approve the request. **Motion by Mr. Szafarowicz that we authorize the request to change the Charlton Beagle Club Manager from Michael J. Brown to Tammy A. Barnes, seconded by Mr. Singer, motion carries unanimously.**
3. Site Plan Application – GSMP Realty Trust. Mrs. Craver stated that attached please find a copy of a site plan application submitted to the Planning Board by Bertin Engineering on behalf of GSMP Realty Trust for site plan approval to construct a 5,000 square foot building for commercial/retail/restaurant usage on an existing 76,195 square foot parcel of land located at 159 Worcester Road (Assessors Map 25, Block A, Parcel 5.1). Said property is zoned Community-Business (CB). You are asked to review the site plan application and forward any questions or comments to the Planning Board no later than Wednesday, November 26, 2014. No comments.
4. 2015 Annual Meeting and Trade Show. Mrs. Craver stated that the 2015 Annual Meeting and Trade Show will be held on January 23 & 24, 2015 at the Hynes Convention Center and Sheraton Boston Hotel in Boston. Attached is the registration form and schedule of events. She would ask if any of the Selectmen wish to attend, to please fill out the registration form and provide it to our office to complete the registration for you as this event fills up quickly. The hotel reservations

must be made by each member directly with the Sheraton Boston Hotel as you will need to provide them with a credit card number. MIIA (our insurance company) will also be holding its Annual Business Meeting and Luncheon during the trade show on Saturday, January 24, 2015 from 12:00 to 1:30pm. Reservations are required so if the Board could please let Mrs. Crave know if you intend to attend, she will make the reservations for you.

5. Suggested Policies for approval:

- Direct Deposit

**- Retiree Insurance Payments**

Mrs. Craver stated that Town Treasurer Keith Arsenault is asking the Board to consider the following two policies which will help to improve the efficiencies in his office:

- Retiree Insurance Payments

All retirees of the town and their surviving spouses are required to have health, life and dental premiums submitted monthly by the Worcester Regional Retirement directly to the Charlton Treasurer's office.

Several years ago the WRRS offered a service to municipalities where the retirement system would withhold monthly amounts due the municipality from pensioner's checks and remit with a report and single check for all participants. This service was greatly appreciated by the Treasurer's office because an inordinate amount of time was spent "chasing" tardy retirees for their health insurance payments. Some paid in advance, other close to the due date and still others required multiple contacts. We still have several employees who are not signed up to participate. Each year more tasks are assigned to the Treasurer's office requiring more time. It makes great sense to improve efficiencies where possible. Requiring all retirees to have their benefits remitted by the retirement system will help.

Mrs. Cooper asked if everyone has to do this or just those on town insurance and the answer was town insurance. Mrs. Craver will add "who are on town insurance" to the policy for clarification. It shall read: All retirees of the town and their surviving spouses who are on town insurance, (all else the same)

**Motion by Mr. Szafarowicz to accept the language as amended by Mrs. Craver, seconded by Mrs. Cooper, motion carries unanimously.**

**- Policy for Direct Deposit**

All employees are required to sign up for payroll direct deposit. The Town Administrator may exempt certain employees from this policy if the employee proves hardship. Currently 85% of employees use direct deposit for their paychecks. We would like that to be 99%. It is possible in the future we will move to providing paystubs on-line replacing the paper system we currently utilize. The more pressing issue is some employees frequently lose or misplace their paychecks or are very part time and may not pick up their paychecks at the respective departments. Even some replacement checks we have issued have not been cashed. As other responsibilities and increased tasks are assigned to the Treasurer's office we must find ways to improve what we already do. It is rare that employees do not have a checking account. Other progressive communities have implemented 100% direct deposit with a minimal employee grumbling. The Town of Charlton accepted M.G.L. ch. 41, sec. 41B at STM of September 26, 1996 by article #14. The Treasurer of any town which accepts this section may pay salaries, wages or any other compensation to any person in the service of such town by means of a deposit to a deposit account(s) of such person.

**Motion by Mr. Szafarowicz to accept the policy on direct deposit as presented, seconded by Mr. Singer, motion carries unanimously.**

VII. Old Business:

1. Charlton Housing Board – public housing response. Mrs. Craver stated that at the October 28, 2014 meeting, Cedric Flower from 1 Meadowview Drive came forward to address the Board about public housing. He stated that public housing is a way for citizens through their taxes to help the elderly and handicapped and low wage earners to afford decent, clean and safe places to live. Mr. Flower stated that the Charlton Housing Authority would be seeking bids from private developers to construct so called affordable housing units on their property. He said the Housing Authority is about to give away the land and the infrastructure that was entrusted to them. Selectman McGrath stated for clarification that this is not a giveaway, it's the way the DCHD has it programmed. It's a public private partnership. The Federal and State Laws have changed and they have to have a certain percentage of family housing as well. Mr. McGrath had asked that we reach out to the Charlton Housing Authority for an official letter so we know what's going on. Mrs. Craver contacted Jean Vincent and explained the conversation. Ms. Vincent referred the information to the Charlton Housing Authority who responded back to the Board. The Charlton Housing Authority has stated that Jean Vincent's role as Executive Director, is to be responsible for the day to day operations of the housing authority, including tenant relations. She is not responsible for creating policy nor long term decision making affecting the Charlton Housing Authority. The Housing Authority understands that one of their tenants came before the Board of Selectmen to discuss the Housing Authority Board's decision to attempt to expand the number of units available to senior and disabled individuals in Charlton. They are aware that there is a critical shortage of affordable housing in Charlton for these citizens. Over the past year, the Board has been in discussion with a consultant who has been assisting them in exploring options that might be available to the housing authority to help remedy to the extent it is currently possible to them. They are continuing with the exploration and this has caused concern for some of their current residents. However, they are not yet at a point where any further discussion with the Board of Selectmen would be of any avail. They suggest that the public and their current tenants avail themselves of the transparency provided by open and televised meetings.







SUBJECT: Town Administrator's Report – for Selectmen's meeting of 11/25/14

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**General Code** – I am happy to report that the General Code project has been completed. We received the final books this past week. The bylaws and such are also on the town's website at [www.townofcharlton.net](http://www.townofcharlton.net). Town Clerk Darlene Tully will be updating the bylaws as needed.

**CMRPC – Regional Traffic Counting Program** – The Central Massachusetts Regional Planning Commission has concluded its Regional Traffic Counting Program for the 2014 season. Attached for our use is a traffic volume summary sheet for each count conducted in the Town of Charlton. Each traffic volume summary sheet includes the location and the date of the count as well as hourly and directional breakdowns and totals. The summary sheets represent the unadjusted traffic volumes as collected in the field.

**By-Law Approval** – The zoning by-laws voted at the October 21, 2014 Special Town Meeting have come back approved by the Attorney General's Office. Just a reminder of what those were: Zoning Bylaw Revision: Allowing Golf Recreational Activities in the Industrial-General (IG) Zone and To amend Charlton's zoning map for land located easterly off of Griffin Road, northerly of Route 20, herein identified as Assessor's Map 27, Block B, Parcels 8,9 10 and 12 by rezoning said parcels from the present zoning designation of Business Enterprise Park (BEP) to Industrial General (IG) zoning designation.

**Town of Charlton Property Revaluation** – The Town of Charlton has completed the Fiscal Year 2015 Triennial Revaluation of all real and personal property as required by MGL, Chapter 40, Section 56 to achieve full and fair cash value property assessments and preliminary certification from the Massachusetts Department of Revenue is still pending. The proposed assessed values reflect the estimated market value of properties as of January 1, 2014. The FY15 preliminary assessments are available for public review during the public disclosure period of Monday, December 1, 2014 – Monday, December 8, 2014 in the Assessors' Office and the Charlton Public Library during regular business hours. We have scheduled the tax classification hearing for Tuesday, December 9, 2014 at 6:45pm.

**Eagle Scout sign project update** – At the Board's July 28, 2014 meeting, Kyle Meskus came forward seeking permission to erect a Community Sign Board on town property as his Eagle Scout project and the Board approved this request pending he contact the abutters and work with the Town Administrator. Mr. Meskus has provided you with an update on the project as he said he would. So far, he has made the top of the sign where the lettering for Charlton Events go and the outside border for it as well. He is working on getting trim for the inside of the border and has also made a support frame for the back of the sign. He will be seeking fundraising to help pay for some of the costs to make the sign. He will continue to keep the board informed of his progress.

## PROPOSED ZONING CHANGE (BEP TO IG) 27-B-8, 9, 10 & 12



## The Town of Charlton Property Revaluation

### Notice of Public Disclosure

The Town of Charlton has completed the Fiscal Year 2015 Triennial Revaluation of all real and personal property as required by Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 40 section 56 to achieve full and fair cash value property assessments and preliminary certification from the Massachusetts Department of Revenue is still pending. The proposed assessed values reflect the estimated market value of properties as of January 1, 2014 based on comparable sales with the Town of Charlton from Jan. 1, 2012 through Dec. 31, 2013. This process is completed by in depth review and analysis of arm's length property sales for the given period. While the total town taxable value has decreased from Fiscal Year 2014 by -11.63%, the total assessed value for single family properties, the largest class, has dropped by -1.69%.

### Public disclosure

The Assessor's office provides reports of all town-wide assessments for review. The FY15 preliminary assessments are available for public review during the public disclosure period of Monday Dec. 1<sup>st</sup> through Monday Dec. 8<sup>th</sup> 2014 in the Assessor's office and the Charlton Public Library during regular business hours. Property records cards can be obtained from the Assessor's office. Please note that records cards available online will not reflect FY15 assessments until late January of 2015.

Should you believe and demonstrate that the assessed value for your property does not accurately reflect the market for the period of Jan. 1, 2012 through Dec. 31, 2013 as of Jan. 1, 2014; the Assessor will review the property and make any appropriate changes during the public disclosure period prior to final certification. After the public disclosure period has ended, values will be submitted to the Department of Revenue for final certification. Upon receipt of final certification the Town can proceed with setting the FY15 tax rate.
