Monday – January 9, 2012

Meeting was held at 10:00am in the Selectmen's Meeting Room with representatives from Mass DOT regarding design completion for the road reconstruction of Rt. 20 from Oxbow Road to the Oxford town line.

The purpose of this meeting was for Mass DOT to meet with the appropriate Town staff in order to solicit comments regarding the proposed design. The proposed reconstruction will include the widening of the existing roadway from approximately 4-11 foot lanes to 4-12 foot lanes with 8 foot outside shoulders and a median barrier with a 4 foot inside shoulder. The reconstruction will also include horizontal and vertical alignment improvements, pavement markings, signage, guardrail, retaining walls, drainage improvements and detention ponds. Traffic signal modifications are proposed at Richardson's Corner and Route 12, while traffic signal reconstruction is proposed at Route 56. In addition, the project will reconstruct and widen the bridge over the Little River in Charlton and the bridge over the French River in Oxford.


