## **Notice of Public Hearing Charlton Planning Board**

In accordance with Sections, 200-7.1 and 200-7.2 of the Charlton Zoning By-Law, the Charlton Planning Board will hold a remote public hearing on Wednesday, September 2, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. via Zoom meeting, meeting ID 87948534727, on the request of Town of Charlton Massachusetts, 37 Main Street, Charlton, MA 01507 for site plan and construction of a 3,600 square foot Dry Storage Building at 23 Trolley Crossing Road. The property contains approximately 3.5+/- acres. The property is located at 23 Trolley Crossing Road. The property ID is Assessors Map 34A, Block A, Lot 1.9 and is zoned Residential Small Enterprise (R-SE).

Pursuant to Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, G.L. c30A, S18, and the Governor's March 15, 2020 Order imposing strict limitation on the number of people that may gather in one place, this meeting of the Charlton Planning Board will be conducted via remote participation.
